3. **Format of Play** 54 holes stroke-play.
4. **Schedule of Events**

06 June 2023 (Tue)	Official Practice Round from 8.30 am. Last tee-off 11.00 a.m. Competitors to register at the Front Office for tee-off time and Caddie Fee Payment MYR 127.20 to be made upon registration. (Tips is included in the caddie fee but additional tipping at your own discretion and Maximum tip is MYR 30.00) Player must leave the course by 4.00 pm.
07 June 2023 (Wed)	1 st Day of Competition: 7.30 am 2 point start at Tee Box 1 & 10
08 June 2023 (Thu)	2 nd Day of Competition: 7.30 am 2 point start at Tee Box 1 & 10 Cut-off 30 & ties for Boys and 15 & ties for Girls based on Gross score.
09 June 2023 (Fri)	Final Day of Competition: 7.30 am 2 point start at Tee Box 1 & 10 Lunch and Prize Presentation: 2.00 pm

5. **Caddies** Players 13 years old and above are **not allowed** to engage caddie during the competition days and are required to carry their own golf bag or to use their own trolley during the competition days.

Compulsory

Competitors 12 years and under are **required** to engage RSGC caddies throughout this championship.

Practice Round



Caddie fee for Practice Round is MYR 127.20 inclusive of 6% Govt. Tax. Practice Round Caddie Chit can be purchased at the Front Office when participants register for a tee-off time. (Tips is included in the caddie fee but additional tipping is at your own discretion and maximum tip is MYR 30).

6. Eligibility **AS PER CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION.**
7. Entries and Closing Date All entries are to be made on the Official Entry Form and must reach the Tournament Office by 12.00 noon, Wednesday, 17 May 2023. The field is limited to 96 competitors. The Committee reserves the right to accept late entries or refuse any entry at its absolute discretion without assigning any reason. This competition is an invitational event. The entrance fee of MYR 420.00 nett (for Malaysian) or USD 150 nett (for non-Malaysian) includes breakfast and lunch over 3 competition days.
8. Registration All competitors are required to register in person at the Golf Club by 12.30 pm on 06 June 2023. Failure to do so may result in the competitors being withdrawn from the Championship.
9. Storage of Equipment The Club will not provide any place for golf bag storage
10. Practice Range Operating Hours will be from 6.30 am to 8.15 pm daily. Players are provided (50) limited Range balls complimentary for warm up before the game from 07 June 2023 – 09 June 2023.
11. Food & Beverages Breakfast and lunch is provided at the Clubhouse on all competition days for participants only.
12. Prizes Prizes will be awarded as follows:
PRIZES

1. Prizes will be awarded as follows based on the gross score: -

GROUP A: BOYS 18 YEARS AND UNDER

- i) 8 places
(Winner, Runner-up, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th placing)

GROUP B: GIRLS 18 YEARS AND UNDER

- ii) 8 places
(Winner, Runner-up, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th placing)

Unless they be the winner of the championship, the leading player in the 15 years and under age category will receive a prize.

The best finishing (Malaysian) Boy will qualify to play in a Regional Junior Competition.

The best finishing (Malaysian) Girl will qualify to play in a Regional Junior Competition.

Each player is eligible to compete for all prizes but to preserve the amateur status of a player, the cumulative value of prizes won by a player must not exceed MYR 4,000. If the cumulative value of the prizes exceeds MYR 4,000, the Tournament Committee



has the right to decide on the prize allocation to limit the cumulative value of the prizes won by that player to not more than MYR 4,000.

DAILY MEDALS

13. Prohibited Actions

Smoking & Alcoholic drinks. All players are prohibited from smoking and consuming alcoholic drinks at all times.

Mobile Phones. Any sounds or use of the mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the course during competition rounds.

Players are reminded that asking for advice from anybody other than their caddie is a breach of Rule 8-1 of the Rules of Golf, the penalty for which is 2 strokes. Talking to parents/coaches/relations/friends/other like-persons may be deemed as so.

14. Rules and Regulations of RSGC

Parent's Consent

Parent's consent is required by all Competitors for eligibility to play in the Competition.

All competitors and visitors are required to observe the dress code and the Rules and Regulations of The Royal Selangor Golf Club.

Acceptable

Ladies & Girls

Acceptable

- Shirts with a collar / mock neck.
- Sleeves shirts are allowed, provided they are conservative and of a type commonly considered standard golf attire.
- Golf shirts designed to be worn out are allowed, provided the bottom edge does not expose the midriff.
- Golf / tailored slacks, capris (mid-calf length trousers), skirts, shorts and skorts.
- Acceptable length of skirts, shorts and skorts are not more than 8 inches above the knee.
- Leggings are allowed, provided they are in full length. Leggings must be worn underneath the skirts, shorts and skorts and must be tucked into the socks.

Unacceptable

- All that is contrary to the above-mentioned Acceptable list.
- Denim jeans regardless of labels, style or colour.
- Combat style / cargo pants with multi pockets, draw-string pants and pants elastic / pleated waistband.
- Tracksuit, athletic or exercise shorts, vests and sweat suits.
- Football or rugby jersey look-alike shirts and any shirts carrying slogans or numbers

Men's & Boys

Acceptable

- Shirts and sports shirts must have a collar / mock neck and with sleeves.
- Shirts with a curved edge at the sides and all types of sports shirts must be tucked into the trousers or shorts before 7.00 pm.
- Tailored / golf trousers, shorts and jeans. Length of shorts is not more than 4 inches above the knee.

Unacceptable

- All that is contrary to the above-mentioned Acceptable list.

All (Men, Ladies, Boys & Girls)

Unacceptable

- Shirts baring / exposing midriff.
- Athletic or exercise shorts
- Sweat suits and vests.
- Jeans that are excessively faded, frayed or with tears.
- Any form of dirty garments.
- Wet garments.

Footwear

- Suitable footwear must be worn. Sandals (shoes with straps at the ankles) are permitted.
- Slippers, crocs and flip-flops are not permitted.

Caps / Hats and Visors

- Members are encouraged to take off their caps / hats and visors whilst inside the Main Lounge, 1893 (Modesto's), Courtyard, Banquet Hall, Heritage Room, The Green, Upper Gallery and Men's Bar – with the exception of traditional / religious head gears.

Reciprocal Members

- Members of Reciprocal Clubs are to make prior arrangement between club to club via Introduction Letter.

Footwear
