3. **Format of Play** 54 holes stroke-play.

4. **Schedule of Events**

19 May 2025 (Mon)	Official Practice Round from 8.30 am. Last tee-off 11.00 a.m. Players to register at the Tournament Registration Counter for tee-off time and Caddie Fee Payment MYR 120.00 (exclusive SST) to be made upon registration. (Tips is included in the caddie fee but additional tipping at your own discretion) Player must leave the course by 4.00 pm.
20 May 2025 (Tue)	1 <sup>st</sup> Day of Competition: 7.30 am 2-point start at Teeing Area 1 & 10
21 May 2025 (Wed)	2 <sup>nd</sup> Day of Competition: 7.30 am 2-point start at Teeing Area 1 & 10 Cut-off 30 & ties for Boys and 15 & ties for Girls based on Gross score.
22 May 2025 (Thu)	Final Day of Competition: 7.30 am 2-point start at Teeing Area 1 & 10 Lunch and Prize Presentation: 2.00 pm

5. **Caddies** Players 13 years and above are not allowed to engage a caddie, and are required to carry their own golf bag or to use their own trolley during the competition days.

**Note: Players below 13 years MUST engage a caddie provided by the Tournament Committee to assist him/her during competition days.**



No Personal Caddies are allowed on the Course.

Caddie fee for Practice Round is MYR 120.00 exclusive of 8% Govt Tax. Practice Round Caddie Chit can be purchased at the Registration Counter when participants register for a tee-off time.

Forecaddies are engaged throughout the championship.

6. Eligibility

**Must Comply to one or more of these criteria:**

- **WAGR Players**
- **National Juniors**
- **Sports Excel Elite Players**
- **Junior Club Champions of any clubs**
- **Wild Card as determined by the Tournament Committee**

8. Entries and Closing Date

All entries are to be made on the Official Entry Form and must reach the Tournament Office by 12.00 noon, Saturday, 10<sup>th</sup> May 2025. The field is limited to 90 players. The Committee reserves the right to accept late entries or refuse any entry at its absolute discretion without assigning any reason. This competition is an invitational event. The entrance fee of MYR 450.00 nett (for Malaysian) or USD 130 nett (for non-Malaysian) includes green fee, insurance for 4 days, breakfast and lunch over 3 competition days.

9. Registration

All players are required to register in person at the Tournament Registration Counter by 7.30 am on 20 May 2025.

10. Storage of Equipment

The Club will not provide any place for golf bag storage

11. Practice Range

Operating Hours will be from 6.30 am to 8.15 pm daily. Players are provided with (30) range balls complimentary for warm up before the game from 19 May 2025 – 22 May 2025.

12. Food & Beverages

Breakfast and lunch are provided at the Clubhouse on all competition days for participants only.



13. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

**PRIZES**

1. Prizes will be awarded as follows based on the gross score: -

**GROUP A: BOYS 18 YEARS AND UNDER**

- i) 8 places  
(Winner, Runner-up, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> placing)

**GROUP B: GIRLS 18 YEARS AND UNDER**

- ii) 8 places  
(Winner, Runner-up, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> placing)

Unless they be the winner of the championship, the leading player in the 15 years and under age category will receive a prize.

The best finishing (Malaysian) Boy will qualify to play in a Regional Junior Competition in South East Asia (internal transfer, accommodation and return flight ticket).

The best finishing (Malaysian) Girl will qualify to play in a Regional Junior Competition in South East Asia (internal transfer, accommodation and return flight ticket).

Each player is eligible to compete for all prizes but to preserve the amateur status of a player, the cumulative value of prizes won by a player must not exceed MYR 4,000. If the cumulative value of the prizes exceeds MYR 4,000, the Tournament Committee has the right to decide on the prize allocation to limit the cumulative value of the prizes won by that player to not more than MYR 4,000.
